

Dress Guidelines for Sforzando String Camp

Our desire here at Sforzando String Camp is that all things would be done to the glory of God. It is also our desire that nothing here at camp would cause anyone to stumble in their walk with the Lord. It is for this reason that we are stating this dress code and requiring everyone at the camp to abide by it. **These are not suggestions; they are requirements that will be enforced.** You will need to read this over and carefully consider everything that you bring with you to camp. The week of camp will be much more enjoyable for everyone if you take the time to choose the appropriate clothing before you come.

Young Ladies:

• Daily Dress

1. Shoes – You may wear casual shoes during the day. Platform shoes, tennis shoes, and flip-flops are not acceptable. Sandals may be worn. Either socks or hose are acceptable.
2. Skirts – Loose fitting, long skirts, jumpers, or dresses are to be worn at all times. Pants will not be permitted. All skirts must comfortably cover the knee at all times. Because you will be on the platform much of the time, we highly recommend that your skirts come to mid-calf or ankle. No open slits will be permitted. No denim or denim-like material should be worn.
3. Shirts – Shirts should not be form fitting and should have a high neckline. No sleeveless shirts are to be worn. Please do not wear any clingy or see-through material.
4. Hair – Hairstyles should be those that clearly define you as a young lady.

• Wednesday Evening Dress

1. Shoes – Dress shoes should be worn for this service. No open-toed, backless, or platform shoes should be worn.
2. Hose – Hose should be worn for this service. Elementary age girls may wear anklet socks.
3. Skirts – Skirts or dresses meeting the daily dress requirements should be worn for this service.
4. Shirts – Shirts meeting the daily dress requirements should be worn for this service.
5. Hairstyles – Hairstyles should be those that clearly define you as a young lady.

• Final Concert Dress

1. Shoes - Black dress shoes should be worn for this performance. No open-toed, backless, or platform shoes should be worn.
2. Hose – Black hose should be worn for this performance. Elementary age girls may wear anklet socks.
3. Skirts – Black skirts following the same requirements as listed above should be worn for this performance.
4. Shirts – White shirts following the same requirements as listed above should be worn for this performance by elementary age young ladies. Ladies above

elementary age and all those in the advanced orchestra should wear solid black, making sure to meet all of the previously given requirements.

5. Hair - Hairstyles should be those that clearly define you as a young lady.

Young Men:

- Daily Dress

1. Shoes – You may wear casual shoes during the day. Tennis shoes and sandals are not acceptable.
2. Pants – Casual, Docker® type pants should be worn throughout the day. Jeans, cargo pants, and shorts will not be permitted. Pants should not be baggy or sagging. Belts must be worn with all pants with belt loops.
3. Shirts – Collared, polo, or button-up shirts should be worn during the day. T-shirts will not be permitted.
4. Hair – Hair should be neatly combed and should not look like you just came out of the shower or your bed.

- Wednesday Evening Dress

1. Shoes – Dress shoes should be worn for this service.
2. Socks – Dark socks should be worn for this service.
3. Pants – Dress slacks should be worn for this service.
4. Shirts – Dress shirts should be worn for this service.
5. Suit Coats – Young men in the advanced orchestra should wear a sports jacket or suit.
6. Ties – Conservative ties should be worn for this service.
7. Hair – Hair should be neatly combed and should not look like you just came out of the shower or your bed.

- Concert Dress

1. Shoes – Black dress shoes should be worn for this performance.
2. Socks – Dark socks should be worn for this performance.
3. Pants – Black dress slacks should be worn for this performance. Young men in the advanced orchestra should wear a black suit for this performance.
4. Shirts – White dress shirts should be worn for this performance.
5. Ties – Black bow ties should be worn for this performance.
6. Hair – Hair should be neatly combed and should not look like you just came out of the shower or your bed.
